The MEDAC advice has been required by July 2020






fishing effort regime OR TAC?




Which are the requirements of the scientific advice

Should the stocks of anchovy and sardine be managed together,


or should they be managed separately?






Which are the requirements of the scientific advice in the case of a fishing effort regime?

on further emergency measures in 2019-2021 for small pelagic stocks in the Adriatic Sea (geographical subareas 17 and 18)




Do you know if any study has been carried out in order to assess the socioeconomic impact of the emergency measures adopted so far?
