EMFF: Commission Proposal

Sustainable Fisheries

Health and safety on board, selectivity of fishing gears, diversification of activities, discard ban, social dialogue and networking (fishermen-scientist), energy efficiency, adding value through marketing and quality.

Sustainable aquaculture

New species, innovative methods (organic) off-shore and non-food aqua, new forms of income (angling tourism, educational activities)

Territorial development of fisheries areas (link to CLLD)

A local bottom-up strategy to seize the opportunities offered by the development of maritime, coastal and inland water areas.

EMFF: Commission Proposal

Control of enforcement of fisheries regulations

Support for: administrative capacity, implementation of CFP rules (discard ban), data validation systems, annual control programmes.

Data collection for fisheries management

Support for: annual work programmes,

CMO implementation

Support for: creation of producers organizations, production and marketing plans,

Bringing outermost regions closer

Specific compensation for additional costs in outermost regions for fishery and aquaculture products.

EMFF: Commission Proposal

- Financing for Integrated Maritime Policy (IMP)
 Maritime spatial planning, studies, test and cooperation projects, conferences, seminars.
- Accompanying measures for CFP and IMP
 scientific advice, control, contributions to RFMOs, Advisory Councils, etc.

Council general approach: Key changes

- Reintroduction of fleet subsidies:
 - Investments on board linked to fishermen complementary activities
 - Aid for young fishermen including inland fisheries
 - Temporary and permanent cessation
 - Engine replacement
- Support for productive investments in aquaculture:
 no longer specific focus on innovation or economic viability of
 individual
 firms except for new entrepreneurs, always in line with the NSP.
- Changing rules and procedures concerning provisions related to non-compliance with CFP rules:
- period for non-admissible applications proportionate to the seriousness



EP- main proposed amendments

- re-introducing support to the replacement of Small-Scale Coastal Fishing vessels (SSCF) older than 35 years by constructing new vessels under some conditions
- re-introducing support for engine replacement under certain conditions
- re-introducing financial support for temporary cessation of fishing activities with a number of restrictions
- re-introducing start-up support for young fishermen to purchase a second-hand vessel subject to some conditions
- re-introducing support to productive investments in aquaculture
- re-introducing the possibility to support the construction, expansion, and modernization of processing enterprises
